

Hello Coaches,

I just wanted to send out a friendly mid season email with a few reminders.

U-6 thru U-10 boys and girls teams should not be entering or logging their scores on NCYSA or any other place including any public team pages. These age groups are not scored by the referees either. The intent at these ages is to foster a positive soccer environment where the score of the game is not a factor. If you have a team that happens to score a lot of goals find unique ways to keep the game enjoyable for both teams. Official scoring does not start until U-11.

One thing you should be doing is contacting the other coaches sometime the week leading up to your game. A simple email or phone call is appropriate and recommended to confirm game time and field location.

For the teams playing within our own club only (in-house) you should have received a coaches list when you received your schedules.

If for some reason a game time doesn't work for you or the other coach the first thing you would need to do is contact Mark Schnell (his email is located on the TBSC website) for home games or the opposing club for away games. This is not always an option. All the clubs are short fields and rescheduling is not always an option. If a game does need to be rescheduled the sooner the clubs and coaches know the better.

Please as we start getting into the rainy season remember to move the goals at practice away from the main playing areas of the fields. We try very hard to get you and your players the best possible game fields. Your help in keeping them in good condition is appreciated (this includes picking up our own garbage).
